



Map of the dredging plan for Wiggins Pass, starting next month. This map can be down-loaded, enlarged, and flipped to horizontal for better viewing and reading. This dredge is expected to remove about 100,000 cubic yards of sand from the channel and reduce the shoaling that normally occurs. This dredge will be a part of the beach re-nourishment process and will improve Barefoot Beach to the North and the Delnor-Wiggins State Park. It should take about a month; the pass will be navigable during the dredge.
